***BUYER OF THE YEAR ***

MANAGER OF THE YEAR

1. It is not a requirement that the Buyer of the Year and the Purchasing Manager of the Year submissions originate from the NIGP Chapter or from a NIGP Chapter Member.

A supervisor, co-worker, or person familiar with the NIGP Chapter Member can submit a nomination for the Buyer of the Year and/or the Manager of the Year. An individual can also nominate themselves for one of the awards.

2. In order to be nominated, the NIGP Member must:
 - A. Be an active dues paying member of the MN Chapter.
 - B. Have attended at least two chapter related functions in the previous twelve months or will attend two in the year nominated.
 - C. Have been actively employed in public purchasing for the entire year in which the candidate is nominated.
3. Criteria reviewed to determine Buyer of the Year and the Purchasing Manager of the Year include:
 - A. Contributions to purchasing
 - B. Contributions to professional development
 - C. Contributions to the entity he or she serves
 - D. Contributions to the MN NIGP Chapter
 - E. Professional Certification
 - F. Contributions to National NIGP
